Design an item of clothing. Is it a summer or winter item? Label the colours and designs.

Practice your colour mixing. Keep a record of what you find.

## Nod oo ceau un daah dagh laa?

Can you dress in just one colour each day? (red on Monday, blue on Tuesday etc) Remember to take a photograph or video or draw and label each outfit.

Cut up or sew or paint an old item of clothing and turn it into something else.
